Reopening information for families

REGISTRATIONS REQUIRED FOR KIDS MINISTRY AND ADULT GATHERINGS

Because of social distancing guidelines still in place, capacity will be limited in the worship auditorium and kids ministry environments at both locations. So, if you plan to attend, you'll need to reserve a spot for both you and your kids to ensure that space is available. The RSVP form will be available at the beginning of each week on the Crosspoint App and <u>Website</u>. We recommend RSVP'ing early in the week if there's a particular gathering you'd like to attend.

Any child attending Crosspoint Kids Ministry needs to be registered for that age/grade group. Room spots are limited.

For families who choose to keep their kids with them in the adult gathering, we understand and support you. You will need to register your child for a seat in the adult gathering. We encourage you to sit in our designated Family Friendly seating areas.



SIGN IN, DROP OFF AND PICK UP

As you enter the building, the Registration Team will verify your reservation and direct you to pick up your child's name tag and parent security tag.

Families are encouraged to maintain social distancing in the hallways. Team Members will greet families and receive children at the door in each room.

Cartersville: We request that only one parent/guardian enter the Kids wing to drop-off and pick up a child. To create a one-way flow of people, we will enter the Kids wing through the elementary lobby and exit through the preschool lobby doors.



ROOM CAPACITY AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

Room capacity numbers have been established to provide ample room for children and Team Members.

We will encourage "airplane arms" and other strategies for keeping distance, however we cannot guarantee social distancing with children. Team Members will comfort, care for, and console children as necessary.

HEALTH AND CLEANING

All Crosspoint Serve Team Members will wear a face mask while serving.

For the health of our families, if a child exhibits any signs of being sick or is unable to follow our safety guidelines, their parent/guardian will be asked to come get them immediately.

We are following CDC Guidelines regarding cleaning and sanitizing and are using approved products. Toys, supplies, furniture, and touch points will be cleaned and/or swapped out between gatherings. Bathrooms will be cleaned after every gathering.
