



ICEBREAKER

Has anyone ever broken a promise to you? Was it hard to trust them again? Why?

CONTEXT

In this passage, the author concluded this chapter with a word of encouragement using the promises that God made to Abraham as an illustration. Because God can not change and can not lie His promises can be trusted. We can anchor our souls in Him because He is unchanging.

READ

Heb. 6:13-20

DISCUSS

When God made a promise to Abraham, He swore by Himself. Why is this significant?

Read verse 17, why did God make an oath? Explain this verse in your own words.

DISCUSS CONTINUED

What is so significant about God never changing? What prevents God from changing?

Read verse 18, what is the purpose the author gives for knowing God is unchanging? Have you ever experienced this refuge in your own life?

What does it mean to “hold fast” to something?

According to verses 19-20, what is the anchor of our soul? What does it mean that He is our forerunner?

NEXT STEPS

Where is your soul anchored? When the storms of life come, do you run away from God or run to Him? Why?

What is one thing you can do this week to anchor yourself more securely to the hope that we have in Jesus Christ?
